**STD/HIV Counseling, Testing & Treatment** (appointment needed) – Receive STD/HIV counseling, testing and treatment of the following conditions for a \$40 fee:

- ◆ Chlamydia
- ◆ Gonorrhea
- ◆ Herpes
- ◆ HIV
- ◆ Pubic Lice
- ◆ Syphilis

**Walk-in services (no appointment needed)** are available to anyone seeking confidential counseling, testing and treatment for the two most commonly reported STDs (chlamydia & gonorrhea). This screening is only available if there are no symptoms of STDs present. The fee is \$20.

HIV counseling and testing services are offered for a \$20 fee.

The Public Health Division serves teens and adults.

Educational programs are available to schools and community groups upon request.



The Waukesha County Public Health Division can assess your health care needs prior to your date of departure. Qualified public health nursing staff are able to offer:

- ◆ Information about disease risks
- ◆ Information about food, water & insect precautions
- ◆ Preventive vaccines and medications
