Timeline for Waukesha County 2011 Farmland Preservation Plan Update and Approval Process

Event Date/Range	Summary of Event/Activity
June 17, 2010	First meeting of the Farmland Preservation Plan update Advisory Committee. Gave overview of assigned tasks. Reviewed Farmland Preservation planning standards from the adopted 2009 County Comprehensive Plan (2009 WCCDP).
July 29, 2010	Second meeting of the Advisory Committee. Reviewed 2009 WCCDP and proposed revisions to the farmland preservation planning standards. DATCP staff attended to allow for a question and answer period on the new law, etc. It was agreed that county staff would prepare draft maps of future AEA consideration for the next meeting.
August-September, 2010	County staff updated countywide agricultural land use maps and assembled historical farmland data for the county.
October, 2010	County staff applied updated farmland preservation planning standards to the updated land use inventory, and developed recommendations for areas proposed for Farmland Preservation and future AEA consideration. Wrote Chapters 1 & 2 of the FP plan.
November 5, 2010	Third meeting of the Advisory Committee. Reviewed proposed plan outline, drafts of Preface, Chapters 1 & 2, and draft standards and maps (Chapter 3) for areas proposed for Farmland Preservation and future AEA consideration by local governments.
December 9, 2010	Held countywide informational meeting. Invited all communities. Explained overall FPP law, planning process, draft planning standards, draft maps, etc. Invited community planners to individual meetings with county staff.
December 6-23, 2010	County staff finished writing draft Farmland Preservation Plan Chapters 2 and 3.
January 5, 2011	Full draft of updated Farmland Preservation Plan sent to Advisory Committee.
January 5-19, 2011	County staff met with municipal planners on request regarding draft plan content and mapping.
January 6, 2011	Presentation on plan update given to Waukesha County Farm Bureau.
January 11, 2011	Fourth and final Advisory Committee meeting. Reviewed results from informational meeting and individual meetings with Town Planners. Reviewed draft Chapter 3 and final recommended areas for Farmland Preservation and to consider for future AEAs.
January 12, 2011	Submitted request for 2011 WCCDP amendment to County Planning and Zoning Division.
February 11, 2011	After completing final plan edits from advisory committee and self certification from Corp Counsel, sent final plan draft to DATCP, advisory committee and communities for their review and comment.
February 17, 2011	Waukesha County held joint county Land Use Parks and Environment Committee and Park and Plan Commission public hearing on draft plan.

Timeline for Waukesha County 2011 Farmland Preservation Plan Update and Approval Process

February 28, 2011	DATCP sent Waukesha County a determination that the 2/11/11 plan submittal was not complete, primarily due to mapping issues.
April 7, 2011	Waukesha County submitted a 2 nd edition of the farmland preservation plan to DATCP, including detailed parcel maps of proposed farmland preservation areas.
April 15, 2011	DATCP notified Waukesha County that the April 7, 2011 submittal was complete.
June 1, 2011	DATCP sent Waukesha County a list of comments and concerns regarding the April 7 submittal, saying the plan cannot be approved in current form.
June 17, 2011	Waukesha County and DATCP staff meets to discuss plan. Waukesha County presents proposed plan revisions.
June 29, 2011	DATCP responded to proposed County plan revisions, outlining which ones they would accept and which ones needed further changes.
July 20, 2011	Waukesha County submitted a 3 rd edition of the Farmland Preservation Plan, addressing items outlined in DATCP's 6/29/11 memo.
August 8, 2011	DATCP certifies the 2011 Waukesha County Farmland Preservation Plan amendment through December 31, 2021.
September 15, 2011	Waukesha County Park and Plan Commission recommended adoption of the 2011 Farmland Preservation Plan as an amendment to the 2009 Waukesha County Comprehensive Development Plan.
October 18, 2011	Waukesha County Land Use, Parks and Environment Committee recommends County Board adoption of the 2011 Farmland Preservation Plan as an amendment to the 2009 Waukesha County Comprehensive Development Plan.
October 25, 2011	Waukesha County Board of Supervisors approves ordinance # 166-58, adopting the 2011 Farmland Preservation Plan as Addendum D to the 2009 Waukesha County Comprehensive Development Plan.
