

Dog Exercise Area Rules

- All dogs entering a County Park are required to have a current dog license.* Dog owners are required to show a current dog license upon request.
- All dogs 15 inches (at shoulder height) and under should use the small breed area. Small dogs may play in the large breed area at their own risk, but not recommended. The small breed area is for dogs 15 inches (at shoulder height) and under ONLY.
- NO ATTENDANT ON DUTY: Users of this facility do so at their own risk.
- Waukesha County will not be responsible for any injury suffered by or caused by any dog.
- Owners are responsible for removal and disposal of their pet's feces.
- No puppies under 4 months of age.
- Dogs in heat are not allowed.
- Dogs must be kept on a 6 ft. leash until inside the double-gated entry. Please make sure gate is closed behind you after entering or exiting. Owners must have in their immediate possession a leash for each dog they are responsible for within the exercise area.
- Food / treats (human or pet), dog chews, and rawhide are not allowed. Owners shall have voice control of their dog(s) at all times.
- Any dog exhibiting aggressive behavior must be removed immediately.
- Children under the age of 16 must be accompanied by an adult and within arms reach at all times. Do not run or chase dogs, and never attempt to pet other dogs unless permission is granted by that dog's owner.

General Information

There is no extra fee to enjoy the Dog Exercise Area.

The Dog Exercise Area is open the same hours as the park – sunrise to 10 p.m. year round.

It is a State Statute that dogs running at large and untagged are subject to impoundment and/or penalties (174.042). A dog license is required for the keeping of any dog over 5 months of age (174.07).

Groomed ski trails are for skiing only.

*Contact your local municipal clerk's office for Dog License.

PARK SYSTEM RULES

- Park Hours - Sunrise to 10 p.m. year round.
- Daily entrance fee or yearly sticker required on all vehicles.
- Dogs must be leashed (6' maximum leash length) until inside the double-gated entry of the Dog Exercise Area.
- Dogs are not allowed on Retzer Nature Center grounds.
- Fires permitted in designated locations.
- Park only in designated lots.
- Hunting, shooting, and trapping are not permitted.
- Liquor is not permitted - beer by picnic permit only.
- Camping is allowed in designated areas - by permit only.
- Horseback riding permitted on bridle paths only.
- Boat launching permitted in designated locations.


