

The County's Green Schools Assistance Program provides new recycling bins to schools, including classroom, cafeteria, hallway, or outdoor bins. Custodial equipment to assist with collections is also eligible for funding. Our staff provides complementary education for students and staff to help promote proper recycling.

Eligible Costs

Covered under Program Funding (subject to prior approval)

- Approved recycling bins/containers, decals, composter or vermi-composter and related equipment
- Busing/transportation costs to Materials Recycling Facility or other related field trip/field work for students
- Disposal of hazardous lab chemicals
- Rain garden plants, mulch and other costs associated with the installation of a rain garden, or other related costs for managing storm water run-off on school grounds
- Expenses related to development of a nutrient management plan for managing turf areas
- Consultant & related costs for developing a natural landscaping design/plan
- Replacing classroom/cafeteria/office/custodial disposables with reusables
- Equipment, materials, or supplies needed to carry out a Green School Action Plan item
