Dear Property Owner:

Waukesha County has hired One Source Consulting to oversee construction of the North Avenue intersection at Brookfield Road. I will serve as the construction project leader and be your primary point of contract for the duration of the project.

Starting the week of April 14<sup>th</sup>, tree removals will begin in preparation for reconstruction of the intersection. Between April 14 & June 14 the roadways may be reduce to a single lane during daytime hours as crews work to remove trees and relocate a gas main along Brookfield Road.

Waukesha County has contracted with Vinton Construction for the reconstruction of the North Avenue intersection at Brookfield Road. Construction is anticipated to begin on July 16, 2014, once Elmbrook Schools are on summer recess. The project is anticipated to be completed by the end of August 2014.

Beginning June 16, 2014, the intersection will be closed to thru traffic with a signed detour route.


Access to residential driveways within the construction area will be maintained on a gravel surface during construction. Delays between 7am and 7pm should be anticipated.

At this time, I would like to remind you that the mail boxes are your responsibility and not the contractors. Some residents directly adjacent to the construction work will likely have to relocate their mailbox for the duration of the project. Please contact your post office for placement instructions.

I would like to take this opportunity to remind everyone of the safety hazards around a construction project. Driving at a reduced speed will make it safer for everyone concerned. Also, a highway project makes a very dangerous but attractive playground for children. Please warn them of the dangers and please keep them clear of the construction area.
