

SHERIFF'S GRIEVANCE COMMITTEE
MINUTES OF OCTOBER 27, 2015

The Waukesha County Sheriff's Grievance Committee was called to order on October 27, 2015 at 3:30 p.m., by Chairman Raasch In the Matter of Charges Filed Against Deputy Sheriff Paul L. Eckert. Present were members Steliga, Henschel, Spangler and Raasch.

Also present were representatives of the Sheriff's Department, Deputy Inspector Torin J. Misko and Deputy Inspector James Gumm, Deputy Paul L Eckert and Police Association Representative, Brent Hart on behalf of Deputy Eckert. Also present from the Department of Human Resources was Sylvana Radmer.

Motion was then made and seconded and was unanimously approved that the Committee go into closed session pursuant to Section 59.26(8)(b) of the Wisconsin Statutes.

Presentation was made by the representative of the Sheriff's Department, Deputy Inspector Misko followed by a statement from Deputy Paul L. Eckert stipulating to the charges and that the requirements of the Sec. 59.26 Wis. Stats. had been followed and as to the requested fifteen (15) day suspension without pay as a result of violations of Rules No. 1.02, 1.5(B) and 1.07.

Following the closing statements and testimony and questions by the Committee, the Committee reviewed the testimony and record in deliberation, taking into consideration §59.26(b)5m of the Wisconsin Statutes, and rendered its decision, a copy of which is attached hereto.
